

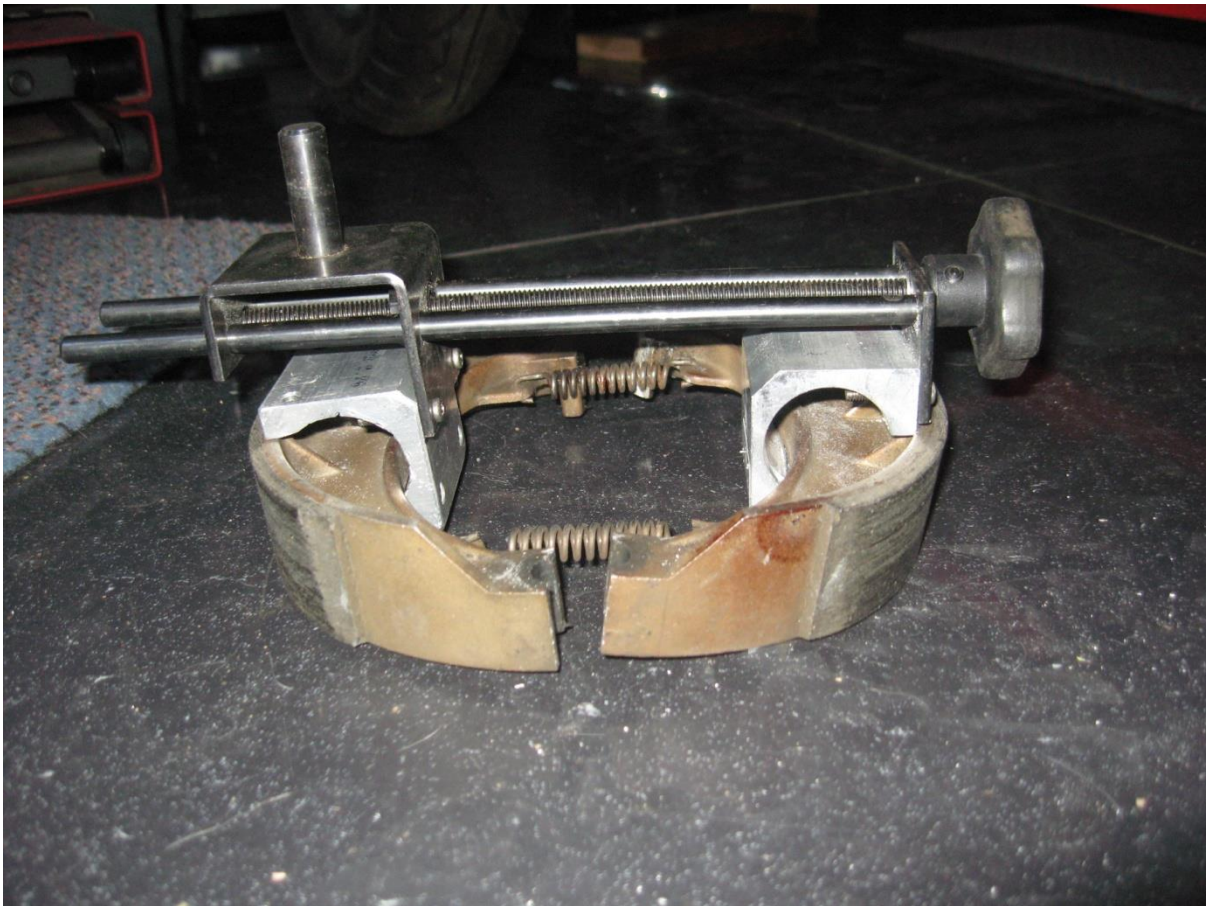
Battling with Brakes and Arthritis
